

Dear Students,

In order to get the 2 credits for BAN 2991 (Module portfolio in Linguistics), you are required to submit in English a short assessment of the following courses in linguistics that you have completed along with altogether at least three test papers (or seminar papers) – if possible -- that you have written for these courses (these will make up your portfolio):

Introduction to English Linguistics
Present-Day English 1: Phonetics and Phonology
Present-Day English 2: Descriptive Grammar

Note that the marks you received for your test papers / seminar papers WILL NOT influence your mark for BAN 2991.

Your assessment should be between 2,000 and 4,000 characters long, and you should give your opinion about the aspects of these courses that you found the most/the least interesting; what you found useful/what you did not find that useful; what connection you can discern between these courses; what aspect(s) of linguistics these courses made you interested in most; to what extent these courses helped in deepening your knowledge of the English language and developing your language skills.

The deadline for submitting your portfolio is **16:00 on the Monday of the last week of the study period**. The portfolios should be submitted both in electronic and in printed form. The electronic version should be sent to bauerne.kiss.reka@kre.hu and to szilvassy.krisztina@kre.hu. Your name should be included in the file name. (You may scan in the test papers.) The printed version should be left in Péter Furkó's folder in the Secretariat of the Institute of English Studies (room 210).

Note that your mark will not be entered in the Neptun system if you have not completed the pre-requisite courses as specified in your programme of study (mintatanterv).
